Mathematics education faculty work closely with the College of Education and Certification Office and with teachers in the local schools.

Responsibilities include teaching courses in mathematics content and pedagogy for pre-service elementary, middle school, and high school teachers at both the undergraduate and graduate levels, as well as graduate courses for in-service teachers. A typical teaching load is four 3-hour courses per semester.

A terminal degree in mathematics education (conferred no later than the beginning of the 2013 Fall Semester) is required.
