Desired Qualifications

- Candidates must have earned a doctorate in mathematics education or a closely related field and will have demonstrated the ability to mentor graduate students.
- Demonstrated potential for successful research in mathematics education
- Record of successful teaching at the undergraduate and graduate level in mathematics education.
- Mathematics teaching experience at the elementary, middle, or secondary levels.
- Experience or interest in innovative, non-traditional mathematics teacher education programs (online, alternative certification, Teach for America, Math for America, UTeach, etc.) and supporting new teachers through the early years of their career.
- Interest or experience with university-assisted schools.
- Experience supporting mathematics improvement and teacher professional development in urban schools.
- · Success in obtaining external funding.
- Interest and/or experience with online learning and instruction.
- Completed graduate coursework in mathematics.

Responsibilities

Duties will include maintaining an active research program, teaching in our mathematics teacher certification courses and our graduate program in mathematics learning and teaching, and taking a leadership role in our new doctoral concentration in STEM Education. The faculty will work closely with the Math Forum @ Drexel, a leading center for mathematics and mathematics education on the Internet. Duties include undergraduate and graduate teaching, student supervision and mentoring, service on committees and participating in professional and industry activities. Teaching will occur at Drexel University's Main Campus and regional locations and scheduling may include day, evening, and weekend courses, both on site and online. Opportunities may exist for summer teaching.
