We require a Ph.D. , or near completion, in mathematics education with a master's degree in mathematics, or a Ph.D., or near completion, in mathematics with significant scholarly or professional experience with secondary mathematics education. The successful candidate should have a strong commitment to excellence in teaching using technology and should be able to teach a range of lower and upper level courses in secondary mathematics education and mathematics, including courses in the use of technology in mathematics, and mathematical methods in secondary mathematics teaching. Course load is 3-3. Will be expected to occasionally teach first year seminars and work with students on independent study and capstone projects.
