Based upon Baylor University's long history and strong reputation for preparing high quality teachers and Baylor's strategic vision, Pro Futuris, the Department of Curriculum & Instruction is initiating a process to advance this nationally recognized program to an even higher level, developing a stronger national model while simultaneously improving the knowledge base from which teachers are prepared. We seek to hire a faculty member who is both scholarly and appreciates the practical nature of the educational enterprise.

**POSITION:** Clinical Assistant Professor (Non-Tenure) in the Department of Curriculum and Instruction: Elementary Education

**QUALIFICATIONS:** The qualifications for the position include:

- Earned doctorate in Elementary Education or closely related field;
- Evidence of continuing scholarship or potential for establishing a research agenda related to preparing teachers in a field-based or clinical setting; and
- Three years teaching experience in an EC-6 setting.

Applicants must have experience and expertise in at least one of the following areas: urban education, science education, mathematics education or English as a second Language.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** This faculty member will have three primary roles: provide high quality instruction for the elementary teacher candidates in field-based seminars and instructional methods courses; provide support/leadership for school improvement on the Professional Development School campuses; and, establish a research agenda related to preparing teachers in a field-based or clinical setting. Responsibilities may include serving as a University Liaison at a PDS, supervising field placements, mentoring adjunct faculty and graduate teaching assistants who supervise or teach in the field based program, and teaching elementary education courses.

Preference will be given to applicants with:

- Expertise in developing and obtaining grants or other external funding, especially to address EC-6 school and community issues;
- Expertise in working with diverse student populations, or
- Experience in professional development schools or other field-based programs.

**RANK AND SALARY:** Clinical Assistant Professor (Non-Tenure Track) The salary will be commensurate with qualifications and professional experience. The anticipated date of appointment is August 2015.

**SUBMISSION DEADLINE:** Review of applications will begin immediately and be accepted until the position is filled.
