

Tenure-Track Math Positions

The Department of Mathematics at Georgia College & State University invites applications for two tenure-track positions at the rank of Assistant Professor. For one of these positions, a Ph.D. in mathematics or a closely related field is required and the area of expertise is open. For the second position, a Ph.D. in mathematics education or mathematics is required and the successful candidate for this position will be expected to teach both mathematics and mathematics education courses in the department. The Department of Mathematics seeks colleagues engaged in scholarship, service, and especially teaching and who are committed to the mission of a public liberal arts university. Excellence in teaching, scholarly activity, and service are requirements for promotion and tenure. Salary will be commensurate with experience and qualifications. Employment will begin August 1, 2011.
