- Significant content preparation in science or mathematics
- Demonstrated knowledge of best practices in science and/or mathematics teaching
- Experience working with pre-service teachers
- Demonstrated leadership in educational settings
- Ability to interact and communicate well, especially with undergraduate students
- Ability to work effectively with a culturally diverse population of students, faculty, and staff.
