Video Conferencing Platform

Zoom Resources

If you have not used Zoom before, we recommend that you [download the Zoom client](#) in advance of the conference. Zoom will automatically download when you enter your first Zoom meeting, but you may not wish to do this right as you are joining your first conference session.

If you already have Zoom on your computer, we recommend that you update to the latest version (5.5.1) for full functionality.

- Mac: Update from within Zoom under zoom.us -> Check for Updates
- PC: select your profile image in the upper right corner, then choose "Check for Updates"

Flipgrid Platform

Poster sessions will be shared in an asynchronous format using Flipgrid. Posters will be available throughout the conference from February 11-February 20, and the link to access the poster session will be available in the Guidebook app and webpage. All AMTE participants should be able to view poster sessions by accessing this link. To comment on posters, you will need to login using a Google or Microsoft account. When viewing a poster, you can leave comments or view others' comments by scrolling to the bottom of the webpage. We encourage you to interact with poster presenters by leaving comments/questions and return at a later point in the conference to view the presenters' response.
