East Carolina University is pleased to announce a tenure-track position in elementary mathematics education (focus on research and teaching at the K-8 level) at the assistant/associate rank. The full-time position is housed in the Department of Mathematics, Science, and Instructional Technology Education in the College of Education. Employment will begin with the 2018-2019 academic year. Responsibilities include producing scholarly contributions in mathematics education; participating in writing proposals for external funding; teaching undergraduate and graduate courses; and providing service to the profession of mathematics education.

The Mathematics Education Program Area consists of 10 full-time faculty – nine tenure-line and one clinical – who work across K-12 mathematics educator preparation. Faculty oversee an undergraduate major (9-12) and two concentrations (6-9 and K-6), a graduate certificate in Elementary Mathematics Education, and a Master of Arts in Education in Mathematics Education with three concentrations: Elementary, Middle School, and High School. Faculty are involved in a number of major projects, including co-teaching/co-planning (as part of the national Mathematics Teacher Education Project), a virtual reality classroom project funded by NSF, a Noyce Scholars research and recruitment grant funded by NSF, and a design based implementation research project with the North Carolina Collaborative for Student Learning. Members of the faculty participate in and provide leadership in national and state organizations and agencies.

The Department of Mathematics, Science, and Instructional Technology Education (MSITE), consists of programs and faculty from Instructional Technology, Mathematics Education, and Science Education. Department programs, faculty, and students have been recognized with many national, state, and university awards. MSITE offers two undergraduate degrees, four graduate certificates, four master's degrees, and a large number of service courses for education majors.

The College of Education at ECU is the largest producer of undergraduate and graduate education professionals in NC. It boasts a large and enthusiastic alumni base, a clinical schools network that hosts field experiences for our students and opportunities for professional development and research, and a newly-opened lab school.

East Carolina University is located in Greenville NC, a college town with a population of about 90,000, situated in eastern NC. From Greenville, you are 90 minutes from beaches, important historical sites, and the Raleigh–Durham metropolitan area. ECU was founded as a teachers college and educator preparation continues to be an important part of the campus mission, even as the university now has over 29,000 students enrolled and houses programs in medicine, dentistry, engineering, business, fine arts, humanities, sciences, and technology.
